WHEREAS, The Jefferson County Commissioners recognize the significance of the Columbus-Pittsburgh Corridor defined as a 160-mile stretch of highway; and

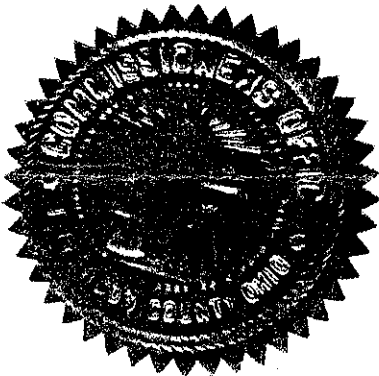
WHEREAS, A coalition of counties has been formed which includes representatives from Coshocton, Franklin, Harrison, Jefferson, Licking, Muskingum, and Tuscarawas Counties; and

WHEREAS, We urge the completion of the remaining 25% of the 160-mile corridor and all of its unfinished sections including the Cherry Valley Road/Ohio 16 Intersection in Licking County. The Ohio 16 Dresden to Coshocton Connector. The Ohio 250 Newcomerstown to Cadiz connector. The U.S. 22 Cadiz to Steubenville connector; and


WHEREAS, The vision of our collective communities realize the economic strength of this corridor upon full completion while also addressing concerns of public safety and relief from the 1-70 corridor;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Jefferson County that on this date, joins with each county along the corridor from Columbus to Steubenville in creating and joining as a partner in the creation of the Columbus-Pittsburgh Corridor Steering Committee which shall meet monthly for the first four (4) months of inception and quarterly on subsequent occasion until such a time that the corridor is completed as a whole and open to traffic. Mr. Thomas Bayuzik, Jr., and Mr. Tony Guida are hereby appointed to serve on the Columbus-Pittsburgh Steering Committee as voting members and are authorized to vote on behalf of Jefferson County to adopt bylaws and conduct business hereto forward as a voting member of the organization for a period of four (4) years at which time this Board shall reconsider its representation to the Committee in a manner consistent with the bylaws and structure which are adopted and implemented.


